O R D E R

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to PARIS CARLBURG of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Fifty and No/100 (\$50.00) Dollars the following described lot:

Lot 3, Block 34, Original Town of Collinsville.

AND WHEREAS, the sale of said lot by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 9745 of the compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1921, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at tax resale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treasurer would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of deed therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other person having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said lot, and the County of Tulsa has no need for said lot for any purpose required and provided by law whatsoever.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled and pursuant to the aforesaid statutes of the State of Oklahoma, hereby approve the sale of said property so made by the County Treasurer to PARIS CARLBURG for a consideration of \$50.00, and it is hereby ordered that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners execute to PARIS CARLBURG a deed conveying to him all the right, title and interest of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in and to said property, and the County Clerk of Tulsa County is hereby directed to attest with his signature and attach the seal of his office.

The above tract of land has been carried on the tax rolls as 120 acres when in fact same contains only 114.45 acres, making a difference and error in same of \$120.00 in value and in tax \$5.64, which he asks for refund.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, Seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the quarterly report of H. L. Coker, Justice of the Peace of District 8, Tulsa County, Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the third quater of the year of 1933, beginning on the first day of July and ending on the 30th day of September, 1933, in Criminal cases, be approved as rendered in the sum of \$10.00.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the County Clerk's monthly report of fees earned and collected in the sum of \$1,473.35 be approved.

On roll call, Commissioner Miller, Gray and Bridges voted "Yes". Motion carried.

WHEREUPON, there being no further business to come before the Board, this meeting is hereby recessed until 10:00 o'clock A.M., Tuesday, October 3rd, 1933.
