

Range 13 East, to the Southwest Corner of Section 30,  
Township 19 North, Range 13 East  
for the purpose of furnishing electricity, light and power to the inhabitants along said route and the right to construct the necessary poles, wires and conduits over, across and along said above described route for the purpose of transmitting and distributing said electric power and current to the said inhabitants residing thereon.

The Board finds that the Sand Springs Home is a corporation, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oklahoma; that it is authorized by its charter and by the laws of the State of Oklahoma to furnish the inhabitants thereof with electricity, electric power and current and the Board further finds that it is necessary for the said Sand Springs Home, in order to furnish electric current and power to the inhabitants along the above described route, to lay, construct, build, maintain and operate upon, over and across the said Lewis Avenue as above described, an electric line and to erect, maintain construct and build the necessary poles, wires and conduits for the purpose of transmitting and distributing said electricity to the said inhabitants along said above described route in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND DECREED, That the Sand Springs Home be and is hereby authorized to and is hereby granted the right to construct an electric line over, upon and across the said Lewis Avenue along the following described route, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southwest Corner of Twenty First Street and Lewis Avenue; thence South a distance of three miles, along the West line of said Lewis Avenue, between Sections 17 and 18, 19 and 20, and 29 and 30, in Township 19 North, Range 13 East, to the Southwest Corner of Section 30, Township 19, North, Range 13 East.

and to erect, construct and maintain the necessary poles, wires and conduits for the erection and maintenance of said line over, upon and across said Lewis Avenue and to do all things necessary for the successful construction, erection and maintenance of said electric high line upon, over and across said highway.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said electric line be constructed in a workmanlike manner and under the supervision of the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the said Sand Springs Home shall be liable for any neglect, actor omission in the construction or maintenance of said electric line over, upon and across said highway and that the said Sand Springs Home shall hold said Tulsa County, Oklahoma, harmless from any liability arising from any neglect, act or omission in the construction, erection, maintenance and operation of said electric line.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That the said Sand Springs Home shall have at any time the right to repair and replace the said line so erected over, upon and across the said public highway, as hereinbefore described.

At a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma held on the 7th. day of January, 1924, motion was made by W. L. North, member of the Board, that the County Engineer be instructed to make survey and design a bridge plan, proposed to be built on the line between Sections 29 and 30, Township 18 North, Range 13 East, considering in the design the using of the old Pole Cat Creek bridge recently removed from a point one mile west of the herein proposed location; making estimates of the cost of same and report such findings to this Board.

Motion was seconded by J. S. Shaver, member of the Board. Motion was duly carried.

It appearing upon the report of the Special Deputy State Examiner and Inspector that up to the close of business November 30th. 1923, that Dr. G. E. Hartshorne, as Superintendent of Health has been over paid the sum of \$75.00 and that there is this amount due from him for salary and it is, therefore, moved by W. L. North, seconded by J. S. Shaver, that the over payment of \$75.00 be deducted from Claim No. 85810, for the month of December, and that the claim be allowed in the amount of \$50.00 and that with the ~~over~~payment of said claim that the overpayment, as above referred to is fully liquidated and settled. All members voting in the affirmative, motion was declared carried.

Motion was made by W. L. North, seconded by J. S. Shaver, that J. T. Roberson of Wekiwa be granted an allowance in the amount of \$10.00 for the months of December, January and February Motion carried.
