

with the County Treasurer, endorsed by the County Clerk, and County Attorney, and presented to the Attorney General, Ex Officio, Bond Commissioner, together with a certified transcript of all proceedings and in connection with their issuance for his approval and endorsement, that thereafter said bonds shall be delivered to the purchaser, upon payment of the purchase price thereof, which shall not be less than par and accrued interest,

The proceeds derived from the sale of said bonds shall be placed in a special fund and used solely for the purpose of improving roads in said township, by draining, grading, gravelling and macadamizing same.

Section 4: For the purpose of providing the necessary funds to pay the interest on said bonds when due, and also to constitute and maintain a sinking fund to be designated as "The Road Bonds of 1921 Sinking Fund" sufficient to discharge the principal thereof at maturity, there shall be and there is hereby ordered, levied upon all the taxable property in said township, in addition to all other taxes, a continuing annual tax upon all taxable property in said township, sufficient to provide funds to pay the interest on said bonds when due and to constitute and maintain a sinking fund for the payment of the bonds as the same matures.

Said tax shall be, and is hereby ordered certified, ~~and is hereby ordered certified~~ levied and extended upon the tax rolls, and collected by the same officer and in the same manner and at the same time as the taxes for general purposes in each of said years are certified, levied and extended and collected. That all funds derived from said tax shall be placed in said sinking fund, which, together with all interests collected on said shall be irrevocably pledged to the payment of the interest on, and principal of said bonds when and as the same fall due.

Section 5: that a Copy of this resolution certified by the County Clerk shall be filed with the Clerk of said county for the purpose of levying such tax as herein provided.
