with the County Treasurer, endorsed by the County Clerk, and County Attorney, and presented to the Attorney General, E x Officio, Bond Commissioner, together with a certified transcript of all proceedings and in connection with beir issuance for his approval and endorsement, that thereafter said bonds shall be delivered to the purchaser, upon payment of the purchase price thereof, which shall not be less than par and accrued interest,

The proceeds derived from the sale of said bonds shall be placed in a special funds and used solely for the surpose of improving roads in said township, by draining, grading, gravelling and macadamizing same.

Section 4: For the purpose ofproviding the necessary funds to pay the interest on said bonds when due, and also to constitute and maintain a sinking fund to be designated as "The Road Bonds of 1921 Sinking Fund" sufficient to discharge the principal thereof at maturity, there shall be and there is hereby ordered, levied upon all the taxable property in said downship, in addition to all other taxes, a continuing annuall tax upon all taxable property in said township, sufficient to provide funds to pay the interest on said bonds when due and to sonstitute and maintain a sinking fund for the payment of the bonds as the same matures.

Section 5: that a Copy of this resolution certified by the County Clerk shall be filed with the Glerk of said county for the purpose of levying such tax as herein provided.
