FRIDAY OCTOBER 7th, 1921.

Pursuant to adjournment the Board of County Commissioners met in the office of the County Clerk, with all members present. The business coming before the Board on this date is the matter of the appeal of the petitioners of School District No. 28 from the decision of the County Superintendent on the 21st day of September, 1921, in annexing the said School District No. 28 to School District No. 22. Witnesses were examined by Blair & Nelson, attorneys representing the appealing petitioners, and A. E. Montgomery, representing the petitioners signing the original petition. Technicalities waived by both attorneys, upon the following testimony.

W. B. BLAIR: "Exhibit A" was formally served on the County Superintendent's office on Last ~~xxxxx~~ Saturday October 1st, 1921, and at the time I left a request with the County Superintendent's office to transmit this paper together with the other records to the County Clerk in order that the matter might be before the Board for hearing on its merits. I will further state that I made a second request, which I think was on Monday October 3rd, and I will further state that on Saturday, October 1st, I made personal service of this Notice Marked "Exhibit B" on the County Clerk, and I think I made an affidavit in writing that service was made at that time. I will state that the instrument filed with the County Superintendent is practically the same as the notice, except the same is called an appeal from the County Superintendent to the County Commissioners of Tulsa County."
