WHEREAS, it is believed to be to the best interests that the Section Line between Sections 1 and 12, Township 18 N., Range 12 East, be declared a public highway. from the east line of said Sections, West to the Arkansas River; that the opening of said road becomesnecessary that drainage may be provided along the said Section line, to drain the lands adjacent thereto, which according to the present condition, causes water to stand upon the public highway at and near the east line of said sections and is a menace to the health and safety of the public and to eliminate the said condition

BE IT RESOLVED: That the said Section line, between Sections 1 and 12, Township 18 North, Range 12 East, be declared a public highway, beginning at the east line of said Sections and extending west to the Arkansas River; that the same be opened for a width not exceeding 50 feet; that the owners of land adjacent be notified, and that the County Engineer be notified to make plans for the opening of the same, and the cutting of such ditches or the laying of tile where necessary, to properly drain the intersection of Peoria Avenue Road, with the east line of said Sections, from such point west to a discharge in the Arkansas River.
