Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the following Resolution be, and the same is hereby adopted, to-wit:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Tulsa County no longer has need of an old one hundred foot span, fourteen foot wide bridge across Shell Creek, located in Section 5, Township 19, Range 11, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of Tulsa County that said bridge and the approaches thereto be sold,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That June 5th, 1947, at 10:00 o'clock, A.M., at the Commissioners room in the County Court House at Tulsa, Oklahoma, be fixed as the time and place to receive sealed bids for said bridge and the two eighteen-foot approaches thereto, the County reserving the right to use the bridge and approaches for a period not exceeding six months from the date hereof, date of delivery to be determined by the County Engineer;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That a notice to bidders be published in three successive issues of the Tulsa Daily Legal News.

Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The matter of the petition of Charles Stunkard and others for the organization of a water improvement district came on for hearing and numerous persons were present and general discussion was had and it appeared that it was not advisable to complete the hearing on this date, so it was moved by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Greer and unanimously carried that further hearing on said petition be put over to meeting of this Board on Thursday, May 29th, at 10:00 O'clock A.M. The motion was unanimously carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that a recess is hereby taken until Thursday, May 29, 1947, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. Upon roll call, motion carried.
