RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONSTRUCTION OF
FARM-TO-MARKET PROJECT WITH FEDERAL-AID

(Contract Method)

WHEREAS, the plans, specifications, and estimates for Oklahoma Federal-Aid Secondary Project No. S-318 (4) being 3.469 Mls. Gr; Dr; 6" Dense Graded Gravel Base Course and Dbl. Bitum. Surf. Crse. from Broken Arrow South have been prepared by this Board of County Commissioners, and approved by the Department of Highways of the State of Oklahoma, and the Public Roads Administration, and

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of TULSA county that said project be forthwith constructed by the contract method in accordance with said plans and specifications,

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Department of Highways of the State of Oklahoma is hereby requested to proceed with the advertising, opening of bids, award of contract, and construction of said project, and said Department of Highways is hereby authorized to expend as much of the Farm-to-Market funds derived from HB 470 of the Twentieth Legislature and HB 255 of the Twenty-first Legislature and allocated to TULSA County as are necessary to obtain Federal participation and to process and construct said project in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimates furnished by TULSA County, the contract price not to exceed the amount of the estimate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That said Board of County Commissioners does hereby certify to the Department of Highways that it has arranged for and will provide well qualified and suitably equipped engineering supervision satisfactory to the Public Roads Administration and the Department of Highways during the construction of said project.
