removed from the right-of-way, all necessary moving, lowering and rearranging of pipe lines, pole lines, and other utility lines has been completed and the right-of-way is now available for immediate possession by the Department of Highways, its officers, agents, contractors, and employees, and it is recommended that said project be adcertised for letting promptly.

## AGREEMENT BY COUNTY TO MAINTAIN HIGHWAYS IMPROVED UNDER PROVISIONS OF FEDERAL HIGHWAY ACT AS AMENDED AND SUPPLEMENTED

The County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, hereinafter referred to as the County, and the Oklahoma State Highway Commission, hereinaftef referred to as the Department of Highways, hereby agree as follows:

- 1. That the Department of Highways will submit a project for the improvement of 3,469 miles of the Secondary Highway from Beginning 2 miles North and 5 miles East of Bixby, thence 3 miles North and .469 mile east to Broken Arrow. A distance of 3,469 miles, to Willow Springs Road ext. and to be designated as Oklahoma Federal-Aid Secondary Project No. S-318 (4), and will recommend its approval by the Federal Works Agency, Public Roads Administration for construction with funds apportioned to the State under the Federal Highway Act as amended and supplemented, subject, however, to the condition that the County shall provide for its proper maintenance after completion of its improvement.
- 2. That said County hereby requests the Department of Highways to submit the aforementioned project with recommendation that it be approved by the Federal Works Agency, Public Roads Administration and agrees that if such project is approved and constructed by the Department of Highways and the Federal Works Agency, Public Roads Administration, it thereafter, at its own expense, will maintain the project in a manner satisfactory to them, or their authorized representatives, and will make ample provision each year for such maintenance.
