NOTICE FOR RECEIVING BIDS

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma will receive sealed proposals at the office of the County Clerk, Court House, Tulsa, Oklahoma on the 16th day of June, 1947 at 10:00 a.m. for the furnishing of all materials and labor for the construction and the construction of a swimming pool for the separate school of Independent School District no. 19 in said Tulsa County, according to the plans and specifications thereby on file in the office of the County Clerk of said Tulsa County, and at which time said proposals will be publicly opened and acted upon.

Each bidder will be required to accompany his bid with a Cashier's Check or its equivalent in the amount of 10% of his bid, and said deposit will be made for the purpose of insuring that the bidder, if his bid is accepted, will enter into a written contract for the construction of said improvement according to the terms of his bid and the plans and specifications.

The deposit of the successful bidder will be retained and credited on his bid and deposit of unsuccessful bidders will be returned thereto.
