Further moved by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer and unanimously carried that the petitions in writing filed by numerous persons that their lands be included in the proposed district should be granted and that the description thereof should be clearly set forth in the Resolution calling for the water improvement district election.

Moved, seconded and unanimously carried that the hearing of further petitions to have lands excluded from the district, and further petitions to have additional lands included in the proposed district, would not be received or heard.

Moved, seconded and unanimously carried that the matter be continued to further hearing before this Board on May 31, 1947, at 10:00 o'clock A.m., at which time only the date of the proposed election, the calling of said election, and the passage of the election resolution shall be considered.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that a recess be taken until Saturday, May 31, 1947, at the hour of 10:00 O'clock A.M. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
