In the matter of the application of MANHATTAN RUBBER HFG. CO. personal property for the year 1924.

This application came on for hearing, upon the recommendation of the Deputy State Examiner and Inspector and the Board being fully advised in the premises and after further conference with the Deputy State Examiner and Inspector, feels that it is a matter of good judgment and to the best interests of the County to order valuation on the tax rolls for the year 1924 against the above in the sum of \$19,310 be reduced to \$9,360.00 and the taxes for the said year be reduced proportionately and this conclusion is arrived at by the Board from the fact that it appears that the Applicant made an error in his return for assessable property for the year, and that the applicant has no property located in this taxing jurisdiction upon which tax warrants can be levied and the taxes as appearing on the tax rolls collected.

THEREFORE, after due consideration in the premises and a full understanding of the facts which are concurred in by the Deputy State Examiner and Inspector, it is hereby ordered that the County Clerk issue a Certificate of Error reducing the valuation of the personal property appearing in the name of the applicant and the tax rolls of Tulsa County for the year 1924 be reduced to \$9,630.00 and the tax extended now on the rolls be reduced according to the rate governing for said year.
