Pursuant to call of County Clerk The County Commissioners of Tulsa County met in County Clerk's office, Present W. L. North, C. H. Cleveland & Geo. McKeehan. On motion of Board the County Clerk was instructed to record Governor's Proclamations annexing portion of Wagoner County to Tulsa County, and same to be sent immediately to official paper for publication. On motion of Board a License was granted to Frank N. Gibson to operate Ferry Boat across the Arkansas River at a point north east of Bixby in Township 17 Range 13 East up and until Nov. 4 1910.
In the matter of rebate on Homestead of Florence, Bertha & Laura Quinn it was shown that same was correct and ordered stricken from Tax Rolls.
