MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR AGRICULTURAL EXTENSION WORK.
BETWEEN
TULSA COUNTY
AND

THE OKLAHOMA AGRICULTURAL AND MECHANICAL COLLEGE
EXTENSION DIVISION IN CO-OPERATION WITH THE
UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

OBJECT: For the purpose of assisting the farmers of this County with their many problems of soil fertility, terracing, economic crop production, live-stock breeding, feeding and management, the prevention and control of crop diseases and insect pests, and the prevention and control of livestock diseases, through educational means, also their problems of grading, standardizing and marketing their farm products, the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College proposes to establish in co-operation with the County, a direct service which shall bring the benefits of the A & M College, the State Experiment Stations, and the United States Department of Agriculture to the farmers of this county, and for the further purpose of encouraging farmers and their families to make the best of all available opportunities, and for the particular encouragement of boys' and girls' club work.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT: The said Tulsa County agrees to co-operate with the Extension Division of the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College and the United States Department of Agriculture in conducting agricultural and home economics Extension work in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, during the year beginning July 1st. 1926 and ending June 30th. 1927.

METHOD OF PROCEDURE For the objects expressed above, the Oklahoma Agricultural and Mechanical College, co-operating with the United States Department of Agriculture, shall select the agent or agents to be employed, such persons to be well qualified to fill these positions by training, education and experience, who shall be satisfactory to the Commissioners of said County.

AND

The County Commissioners agree to pay Two Hundred Twenty Five (\$225.00) Dollars per month on the salary of a County Agricultural Agent, and One Hundred Twenty (\$120.00) Dollars per month on the salary of a County Home Demonstration Agent for a period of Twelve (12) months, beginning July 1st. 1926. The County Commissioners further agree to furnish an office and to appropriate the following amounts to apply on the expenses of the County Agent \$2,500.00 for the County Home Demonstration Agent (\$1200.00) and \$1800.00 for Office Help.
