In the matter of petition of F W LAUSEN for permission to lay a pipe line, thru, under and across certain highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the following Order was made:

O R D E R

NOW, On this 3rd. day of December, 1928, the matter of the petition of F W Lausen for permission to lay a pipe line under through and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said F W Lausen be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said F W Lausen, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

A proposed two inch low pressure gas pipe line on the North side of the Public Highway extending from the West corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) thence along the said highway and along the East Boundary line of the said land thence North along the East line of the said Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the said Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) all in Section One (1) Township Nineteen (19) Range, North 14, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constricted as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.
