MINUTES

Management Conference  
Thursday, August 16, 1984

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: Melvin C. Rice, Chairman; Lewis Harris, Member. Member absent: none. Others present: Clayton Edwards; Susan Morgan; Janice Lintelman, Eric Shoeff; Mike Kimbrell; Pam Infield.

Melvin C. Rice, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. and the following business was transacted:

Edwards reported on the conditions at Irving School and the work being done presently to finish repairs before turning the property to the new owner, Steve Cowen. Edwards was directed to set up a meeting with Mr. Cowen, Buck Rudd, Ray Jordan, and Mel Rice at Irving School next week for an inspection of the property.

Ray Jordan presented a request for the County to accept maintenance of drainage channel located in the Candlestick Beach III subdivision. Subject to certain conditions, the Board concurred with Jordan's recommendation to accept maintenance; this will enable FEMA to remove the floodplain designation from approximately 100 residences. Jordan was directed to proceed with assistance from the District Attorney's office.

Jordan also requested permission to accept a drafting project requested by the Tulsa County Public Facilities Authority. The Board agreed that either Engineers or Administrative Services
