A resolution was made by the Board of County Commissioners, that the County Physician be paid a salary of \$200.00 per month, beginning July 1st, 1915, said contract to be in full force and effect during the life of the appointment of the present County Physician, Dr. W. W. Brodie, said County Physician is to make a detailed report at the end of each month, filing one with the County Clerk and mailing a like copy of such report to each of the three County Commissioners.

The bond of H. D. Maxwell, County Superintendent of Public Instruction, filed, and his appointment of Minnette M. Hedges as Assistant Superintendent Instruction, filed and approved.

An order was made that all Township Road Øverseers be notified that their duties as Road Overseers in their respective Townships would cease on June 30th, on account of the new road law which goes into effect on that date, and that it would be necessary for all appointments to be made at their regular meeting, July 6th, said order was mailed to each road overseer at his respective Post-office, notifying him of the above fact.

An order was made and notices was mailed to Ed. Bolin at Skiatook, Oklahoma, he to serve same on Annie Penn, J. M. Hardesty and Addie Hardesty, to vacate and open up a thrity-three (33) foot roadway between Sections Twenty-five (25) and Twenty-Sim (26) of Township Twenty-two (22), Range Twelve (12) East, Tulsa County.

There being no further business the Board adjourned until Tuesday July 6, 1915.
