

Tulsa County, Oklahoma will receive sealed proposals at the Office of the County Clerk, in the Court House, Tulsa, Oklahoma, until, 10:00 o'clock AM Monday, May 18th. 1931 at which time, or as soon thereafter as said matter may be reached, in session assembled, the said County Commissioners will proceed to open said proposals and consider the awarding of the contract for the erection of improvements on the Grand Stand in connection with the Tulsa State Fair to be erected at 17th. Street and Louisville Avenue, Tulsa, Oklahoma.

All labor and materials are to be in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by Messrs Endacott and Goff, Architects, 627 Wright Bldg., Tulsa Oklahoma, copies of which are on file with the County Clerk of said County and may be examined by those interested. A deposit of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars for each set of plans and specifications taken out for estimating purposes will be required as a guarantee that same will be returned to the Architect, in good condition and a bona fide bid will be submitted to the Board of Commissioners.

Financial and experience questionnaires must be filled out and filed with the County Clerk at the same time and as a part of the proposal, and the Board of County Commissioners may, at its option, refuse to consider any proposal which does not comply with this condition and requirement.

Bids to be entitled to consideration shall be on the forms provided and all blank spaces shall be filled, numbers shall be stated in both writing and figures the signature shall be written.

Also, each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check drawn on a solvent Bank of the State of Oklahoma, payable to said Board of County Commissioners or Surety Bond satisfactory to the Board of County Commissioners in an amount equal to ten (10%) per cent of the gross amount of the bid, as a guarantee that should the bidder be awarded the contract he will enter into an agreement for the work, satisfactory to the Board of County Commissioners and their attorney, and that he will furnish the statutory and surety Bonds as required by law.

Unsuccessful bidders may obtain their check or other securities, within ten days after bids are received.

The Board of County Commissioners reserve the right to reject any or all bids.
