Attention of the Board was directed by the County Attorney to certain bond forfeitures recetly taken in the District Court in something like one hundred cases, and it appears that these cases have been pending for the past four and five years, and it is doubtful if any recovery of monies can be had from the sureties because of removal, desposing of property scheduled, and the bonds being otherwise insufficient and at no time considered a good and proper bond, and that he be authorized to use his discretion in making settlement of these and other bonds where recovery of money is doubtful.

Therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners that the County Attorney be, and he is hereby directed and requested to use his best judgement in all bond forfeiture matters and make such settlements for cash as he may be able.

It was moved by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Geo. E. Gilmore that the resolution be adopted, and upon being put, same was unanimously adopted.
