Motion was made by Ed Baker and seconded by A. W. Lucas that the section line between the East half of Sections Twenty three (23) and Twenty six (26) in Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Twelve (12) East, be opened and the same graded for use of the public. Motion carried.

Complaint of road.

A complaint was made by Chas Brown as to the condition of the road between sections twenty three (23) and thirty (30) in Township Twenty (20) North, Range Twelve (12) East, and the Board was asked to investigate said road and that it be graded so it could be used by the public.

Overseers OK for all Roadwork.

A motion was made by A. W. Lucas and seconded by Ed Baker that all raod claims after having been made up by the County Engineer from time sheets furnished him by the different Road Overseers and OK'ed by R. K. Hughes, County Engineer, that said claims have the OK of the Township Road Overseer, that said claims must be signed by the party in whose favor it is drawn and his signature witnessed by two reliable persons or acknowledged by a Notary Public, which will make the claim a competent claim for the County Commissioners to accept and issue a warrant for against the Road fund of Tulsa County.
