Moved by Commissioner Harris, seconded by Commissioner Rice, that pending review and analysis of Tulsa County's data processing needs and associated legal considerations a moratorium is hereby declared on the lease, purchase, or installation of data processing equipment by all Tulsa County Departments until further notice; said moratorium to become effective immediately after passage of the motion. Upon roll call, Commissioner Harris, yes; Commissioner Rice, yes; Commissioner Young, yes. Motion carried.

Discussion was held concerning payment to Solnok & Associates, in the amount of \$3,052., for work on the meter-level of the parking area. The Board decided to pay this from Jack Helton's budget which will be reimbursed at a later date if needed.
