

COMMISSIONERS JOURNAL, TULSA COUNTY, OKLA.

(August 2nd, 1915, continued)

A motion was made by Ed Baker and seconded by A. W. Lucas that viewers be appointed to assess damages in the Southwest Quarter of Section Seventeen (17) Township Eighteen (18) Range Thirteen Thirteen (13) East in Fry Township, said viewers appointed being, John T. Kramer, S. A. Orcutt and M. A. Steele, said viewers to meet on said ground on Wednesday morning, August 11th, 1915 at 10 o'clock A.M. and view a Roadway as staked and designated, by R. K. Hughes, County Engineer, through said land. Motion carried. Viewers appointed for road.

A committee of Citizens came before the Board of Commissioners and asked that a special collector be appointed by the Sheriff on a salary basis, said salary to be named by the Board of County Commissioners, to collect all delinquent, personal taxes in Tulsa County, and bring suit for collection, when same is not paid on demand. The Board referred same to the County Attorney, for his approval and written opinion on the above procedure. Tax Collector asked for.

There being no further proceedings the Board adjourned to meet again, Monday August 16th, 1915 at 9 o'clock A.M.

Monday, August 16th., 1915.

The Board of County Commissioners, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met in their Rooms in the County Court House, Monday August 16th., 1915 at 9 o'clock A.M. in Adjourned Session.  
Present:- C. S. Avery, Chairman, A. W. Lucas, and Lewis Cline, Clerk.  
Absent:- Ed Baker.

It was ordered by the Board of County Commissioners, that the Penalty be stricken from the Taxes on the following described lands, for the year 1909:-  
The Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section Twenty eight (28) Township Nineteen (19) Range Thirteen (13) East, The Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section Twenty seven (27) Township Nineteen (19) Range Thirteen (13) East, the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section Twenty seven (27) Township Nineteen (19) Range Thirteen (13) East. Penalty stricken from 1909 Taxes.

A Committee of Citizens of Bellview came before the Commissioners to have them take some action in regard to the Wm. Childers allotment, which was being used for the Campers who happen to come through Tulsa, it being declared by said Committee that same was a nuisance and was costing Tulsa County at the rate of \$300.00 per month to take care of Small-pox cases, and other sickness, which was being looked after by A. M. Welch, County Humane Officer. The same was referred to the County Attorney to take up the legal part and devise some means of getting rid of said nuisance. Request to get rid of Campers in the Bellview Add'n.

A resolution was passed that the County Clerk invite the Boards of County Commissioners, County Clerks and County Engineers of Washington County, Rogers County, Muskogee County, Wagoner County, Osage County, Okmulgee County, and Creek County to meet in Tulsa on August 26th, 1915 at 2 o'clock P.M. and confer with the County Commissioners of Tulsa County and map out the State Road across Tulsa County ties to intersect with the State road of the several above named counties so as to have one continuous State Highway, across all of said Counties. Invitation to adjoining Counties.

A Committee of Citizens of Bixby, consisting of C. R. Privett, George Wiles, Othello Henderson, Claude Howell, and others, met with the County Commissioners for the purpose of getting the consent of the Commissioners to begin the building of the rock road Southeast of Bixby and were given the consent of the said Board and rock was ordered shipped to Bixby, at once. Request for Bixby rock-road.

The appointment of John Hedgecock as road overseer in Dawson Township was made, he to serve until January 1st, 1916, in such capacity. The appointment of D. S. Johnson as road overseer in Lynn Lane Township, was made, he to serve until January 1st, 1916 in such capacity. The appointment of D. M. Tiller as road overseer in Boles Township was made, he to serve until Jan 1st, 1916, in such capacity. Road overseers appointed.

Appraisers were appointed to appraise and assess damages through the Southwest Quarter of section Seventeen (17) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East in Fry Township, and through the southwest quarter of section Twenty-eight (28), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, said viewers appointed being, John T. Kramer, S. A. Orcutt, and A. B. Davis, they to meet with the County Engineer at his request and view and appraise said damages and make their returns to the County Clerk at a date to be named by the County Engineer. Said viewers to be notified by the County Clerk of the date set. Viewers appointed to appraise road, Fry Township.

There being no further business to transact the motion was made and carried to adjourn, to meet again on August 26th 1915 at 9 o'clock A.M.
