

2. That it cannot put in its said gas pipe line with the consent and permission of your Honorable Body to use said highway, and in order to complete its said six inch gas pipe line it is necessary for it to have the power and authority to construct the said line above mentioned across, under, along, upon and over the specified highways of said County.

3. That in putting down the said gas pipe line this company will comply with all the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing the constructing and operation of same, and will likewise comply with all the rules and regulations provided by this Board, or other competent authority of the State of Oklahoma, for the construction and operation of the same.

4. Your petitioner herewith submits as a part of this, its petition, a plat or map showing the definite location of its said six inch gas pipe line.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner respectfully represents that it be authorized and empowered to put down, lay, maintain and operate this said gas pipe line for the conveyance of natural gas along, across, over, under and upon the said specified public highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, under such rules and regulations as may in the judgement of your honorable Body be necessary for the protections and preservation of said highways, to avoid any inconvenience to the public in the use of same, and for the protection of said county against liability for damage by reason of the construction, maintenance and operation of the same.

IN RE Application of CONSOLIDATED GAS COMPANY, Ltd.,
a Common Law Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, to construct
pipe lines over, under, along and across the public
Highways of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Along the township lines between townships 22 and
23, from the eastern boundary line of Tulsa County and
in a westerly direction to a point where the said
township line intersects the Range line between
Ranges 13 and 13 East, said line to be a six inch gas line and to
be used for the purpose of conveying and transporting natural
gas.

Now, on this the 18th day of October, A. D. 1921, at a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, held in compliance with and according to law, the application of the CONSOLIDATED GAS COMPANY, Ltd., a Common Law Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the right to put down, construct, and operate a six inch gas ^{pipe} line upon, along, across and over the above specified public highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which application is in writing and sets forth that it is necessary for the purpose of further advancing the business of said company in its purchasing, marketing, transporting and conveying of natural gas as in said petition stated, to lay, construct, operate and maintain said pipe line along, under, over and across the said specified highways of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, comes to be considered, and said Board after hearing the said application and considering the same and being fully advised in the premises finds that said application should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, DECREED AND ADJUDGED, that the said CONSOLIDATED GAS COMPANY, Ltd., of Tulsa, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to lay, put down, construct, maintain and operate this its gas pipe line for the conveyance, transmission and transporting of natural gas under, upon, across, over and along said
