R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, Riverside Drive within the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa is a public highway extending from 11th Street in the City of Tulsa to or near the Midland Valley bridge across the Arkansas River, and

WHEREAS, Riverside Drive within the County of Tulsa is a paved highway from 31st to 51st Streets, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the public convenience that a highway be constructed by Tulsa County from 31st to the Midland Valley crossing to close the gap that now exists, and

WHEREAS, it has been impossible to agree with the owners of land along said proposed highway for the purchase of a right-of-way for said public highway, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to condemn the following strip of land for said highway purpose,

THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, that the County Attorney be instructed to institute condemnation proceedings for the purpose of condemning the following strip of land as a right-of-way for said highway purpose, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 25' North and 21.3' West of the South 1/4 corner of Section 13-Township 19 N-Range 12 E, running thence West along the North right-of-way line of 31st Street a distance of 113.89' to a point on the meander line of the Arkansas River; Thence North 8° West along said meander line a distance of 470.75' to a point; Thence North 17° West 433.0' to a point on the Southerly right of way line of the Midland Valley Railroad; thence North 74° 03' East along said right of way line a distance of 112.55' to a point; thence South 15° 57' East a distance of 102.1' to a point; thence South 11° 55' East a distance of 831.3' to the point of beginning. Containing 2.15 acres more or less; all in Lot 7-Section 13-Township 19 N-Range 12 E, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Moved the adoption of the above resolution by Commissioner Miller, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, all voting in the affirmative, the resolution was declared adopted.
