Motion made by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the Drainage Assessment of Polecat-Rock Creek Joint Drainage District No. 1 made against the following land:

The South Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section thirty (30), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range (13) East containing 120 acres more or less, be stricken from the tax rolls, as per separate order entered, filed under Miscellaneous No. 55087, and hereby referred to. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey that the Claim No. 14102 in the amount of \$216.15, by Dan A. Rowe, for balance of salary for the month of February, 1951, be disallowed. Upon roll call, motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Hardesty that the petition asking the County Commission to vacate 12th Street from the west side of the Northeast Quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Eleven (11), Township Nineteen (19) Range Fourteen (14) East between Blocks One (1) and Two (2) and Four (4) and Five (5) of Lynn Lane Estates, a distance of One Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty Five (1,385) Feet, be granted. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Commissioner Hardesty - Yes; Commissioner Caffey - Yes; Commissioner Bailey - No. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and unanimously carried that all receipts and expenditures pertaining to the organization of Water Improvement District No. 19 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and the construction of its public distribution system and the levying of the assessments and insurance of bonds in payment therefore be ratified and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Caffey, seconded by Commissioner Bailey and unanimously carried that the unexpended portion of the cash received in the pre-payments of assessments made of Water Improvement District No. 19 of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the sum of Eight Hundred Twenty-nine and 60/100 (829.60) Dollars be deposited in the sinking fund of Water
