Know All Men By These Presents, that the County of Tulsa, in the State of Oklahoma, acknowledges itself to our and for value received hereby promises to pay to bearer the sum of \$____ on the first day of December, A.D. 19____ together with interest on same from the date hereof until paid at the rate of 5 per centum per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of June & December in each year, as evidenced by and upon the presentation and surrender of the interest coupons hereto attached, as they severally become due. Both said principal and interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America at the fiscal agency of the state of Oklahoma in the city and state of New York, or, in the event of the discontinuance of such agency, then at the National Bank of Commerce in said city and state of New York. And for the prompt payment of this bond with interest as aforesaid at maturity, the full faith, credit and resources of said county are hereby irrevocably pledged. This bond is one of a series of bonds aggregating the amount of \$75,000.00 of like date and tenor, issued for the purpose of raising funds with which to construct bridges in and for the County of Tulsa, in the state of Oklahoma, pursuant to more than a three-fifths vote of all the qualified electors of said county, voting at an election duly called and held in all respects according to law in said county, on the 19th day of October, A.D. 1909, and pursuant to resolutions duly adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, and in all respects under and by virtue of and in full compliance with the provisions of an act of the legislative assembly of the state of Oklahoma, entitled, An act to enable the County Commissioners of any county in the state of Oklahoma to issue the bonds of such county for the purpose of building, constructing, repairing or acquiring bridges and declaring an emergency, approved March 19, 1909 (being Article 2 of Chapter 32 of the Session Laws of the state of Oklahoma of the year 1909).
