WHEREAS, the Highway Department is in need of a truck and has found that a trade or exchange can be made with the Fred Jones Motor Company for a 1936 Chevrolet Truck, Motor No. T-61-13671, in exchange for said Chrysler car and a further consideration of payment by Tulsa County to Fred Jones Motor Company the sum of \$145.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to transfer title to the aforesaid Chrysler Car and deliver the same to Fred Jones Motor Company in exchange for said Chryrolet Truck when accompanied by a proper transfer of title to Tulsa County, and that the County Highway Department be authorized to draw a claim to the Fred Jones Motor Company in the sum of \$145.00 payable from Account No. 8, designated as "Purchase of Tools, Trucks and Equipment" of the County Highway Department Account of the General Fund.
