Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the ~~request~~ Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$10,113.77, be and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the Restricted County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$5,336.53 be, and the same is hereby approved and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by Cal Crum, Court Clerk, for the District Court for the month of October, 1941, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

The minutes of November 3rd, 4th, 10th and 12th, 1941, were read and there being no objection to the same, motion was made by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that they stand approved as read.
