That the assessments hereby levied against the several tracts, lots and parcels of land shall bear interest from the date hereof at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum until paid, and said assessments shall be payable in twenty (20) equal annual installments with the interest on the whole amount remaining unpaid respectively, shall be payable on or before the first day of September, 1938, and the succeeding annual installments with interest on the whole amount remaining unpaid respectively shall be payable on or before September 1st of each of the succeeding years, provided, however, that the owners of property hereby assessed shall have the privilege of paying the amounts of the respective assessments without interest within thirty days from the date of the publication of this resolution, which publication is hereby directed to be made on the 27th day of April, 1938, in the Tulsa Daily World, a newspaper printed and published in the City of Tulsa, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and of general circulation in said Tulsa County and said Water Improvement District.
