

The following Resolution was presented by Commissioner Kinkaid, who moved its adoption. Seconded by Commissioner Gray.



Moore, United States Senators from Oklahoma, to give prompt consideration to a survey for the purpose of controlling floods of the Arkansas River and its tributaries in the immediate vicinity of Bixby and Leonard, Oklahoma. "
