AFTER RECESS 2:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., with all members present and presiding as before.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, that the Superintendent of the County Farm & Home be given complete charge at the County Farm & Home in so far as the management of the help is concerned. Motion seconded by Commissioner Shepard, and upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Sallee, Aye; Morley, No. Mr. Morley: I think it is absolutely illegal to give the Superintendent the authority to hire and discharge the employees out there - - - Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, that Ed Lantz be discharged as Superintendent of the County Farm & Home. Motion lost for the want of a second.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that Paul Gahan, head cook at the County Farm, be discharged. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, No. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Shepard, seconded by Commissioner Sallee, that C. B. Wroten be discharged as farmer at the County Farm as of November 10th, 1939. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Sallee, Aye; Morley, No. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Shepard, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that Logan Lee be appointed head cook at the County Farm as of November 15th, 1939. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Pass. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Shepard, that the bid on Lot 5, Block 4, Exposition Heights Addition to Tulsa, made by Wade Peters, be and the same is hereby rejected. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.
