Bond Continuation. The First National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, filed a Bond Continuation Certificate, signed by the officers of the Southwestern Surety Company, in the amount of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) and same was approved.

Colored Justice of Peace. The Petition of Freeman Martin (Colored) was presented for appointment of Justice of the Peace for the Colored Population, and there being no remonstrance of any nature, and petition being signed by a great many of the Attorneys and best citizens of Tulsa, the appointment was given him, to serve until the next General Election, unless removed for cause. He, filing bond and taking Oath of Office, and same being approved.

Dr. Gilbert's Claim. The Claim of J. B. Gilbert for \$95.00 was Disallowed.

Mr. Evans Salary. An order was made by A.W. Lucas and seconded by Ed Baker that Chas. Evans be allowed Twenty five Dollars (\$25.00) per month for special work, performed by him, in connection with the new Road Laws, which went into effect July 1st 1915.

Bids on Sigler Hill. It is ordered by the Board of Commissioners that the Road work to be performed between Sections two (2) and three (3), Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, known as Sigler Hill be advertised for Bids for the purpose of letting said work by contract to the lowest bidders. Bids to be opened September 27th., 1915 at 10 o'clock A.M.

Old man to Poor Farm. It is ordered that Mr. Freeman an old Gentleman be admitted to the County Home at a compensation of \$12.00 per month, said money to be paid by his son, E.L.Freeman.

Notice to City of Keifer. It is ordered that the City of Keifer be Notified to stop all work along or across all Highways in Tulsa County, until the bills due Tulsa County, which are now outatanding, have been paid.
