## RE SOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has heretofore taken and appropriated for public use as a highway, certain lands of one O. R. Howard, situate in Sections 14 and 23, in Township 19 North, Range 12 East, in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and

WHEREAS, at the time the lands aforesaid were so appropriated, it was agreed by and between the Commissioners and the said O. R. Howard, that the Board of County Commissioners when would vacate and close the portions of two certain highways which do not serve the public nor are they necessary or convenient for highway purposes, same being described as follows, to wit:

1. All that portion of the public highway or road which follows or would include the section line running East and West dividing the mouthwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 14, and the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 23, all in township 19 north, range 12 east, and which lies between the hærdsurfaced public highway and the right of way of the St. Louis and San Francisco Railway Company.
