

Rice said he and the other Commissioners would like to have design and cost estimates ready so a bond issue could be offered to the voters later this year. He also said more than one design firm could be selected. In addition to the principle facility, county officials also want to include space plans for juvenile and mental health prisoners. Rice explained to all the architectural firms any payment for services rendered in connection with this project will be based solely upon passage of a bond issue and construction of a new jail. Selph added, that before any designs can be approved, the Board will decide how many prisoners a new jail would hold. Harris stated it would be doubtful that a 1,030-bed jail would be built as proposed in a 1985 study by the Iowa-based Durrant Group.


Selection of an architectural group will be decided at a later date.
