R E S O L U T I O N

BE IT RESOLVED: By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, that the County Assessor of said County be and he is hereby authorized to begin the assessing of all property in said County, subject to ad valorem taxation for the year 1929 at the time and in the manner and under the procedure, as provided by the laws of the State of Oklahoma now in force and effect.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, upon closing the office of Delinquent Tax Collector, Joe T Parkinson, had collected and deposited in his Depository Account with the County Treasurer as partial payments upon delinquent personal taxes the sum of \$1,418.22, as per the attached list, and

WHEREAS, said Joe T Parkinson informs this Board that the collections of the balance of taxes due on said delinquent list hereto attached is practically impossible for various reasons, and

WHEREAS, said Joe T Parkinson is about and will soon enter into other employment and desires to make full settlement with Tulsa County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That said Joe T Parkinson be and he is hereby authorized to pay to Wm. L. Smiley, County Treasurer, the sum of \$1,418.22, less his commission as states in his contract of employment, and upon receipt of the sum to be paid to said County Treasurer, the County Treasurer is hereby authorized to credit the tax rolls with such partial payments less said Commission, or issue his miscellaneous receipt therefor and hold such amount in escrow subject to future disposition.
