

Joint Meeting Proceedings

Pursuant to call of Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma acts call for joint meeting with the county Commissioners of Wagoner County to distribute the expense as to the territory recently annexed from Wagoner County to Tulsa County. The Boards of said counties met in Joint Meeting in County Clerk's Office at Tulsa Oklahoma on the date above mentioned with the following members present.

Wagoner County, G. D. Sleeper, P. D. J. Hudson & A. L. Hansen, Commissioners, J. E. Heldt, Clerk.

Tulsa County, W. L. North, C. H. Cleeland & Geo. McNeekhan, Commissioners.

C. J. Rogers, Clerk. W. L. North, Chairman. Tulsa County called the meeting to order. On motion of Cleeland seconded by McNeekhan, A. L. Hansen was made chairman of the joint meeting. On motion of Sleeper, seconded by McNeekhan C. J. Rogers was appointed clerk of said meeting. Each of the above motions prevailed and was declared carried by the chairman. On motion of Sleeper seconded by McNeekhan a committee composed of Heldt & Cleeland were selected to submit a report as to a proper distribution of the expense of each county. Motion put and declared carried by the chairman. Recommendations of committee read and accepted.

On motion of Sleeper seconded by Hudson, by agreement The Tulsa County Commissioners authorize the county Clerk of Tulsa County to draw warrant for \$3250 without interest payable the first day of March 1910 in favor of Wagoner County in settlement in and for the territory recently annexed to Tulsa County, Tulsa County to collect the 1909 taxes and the delinquent taxes for the year 1908.

The Chairman of the meeting put the motion and declared it carried. On motion the joint meeting adjourned.
