


Thereupon the Holcombs presented their protest which was filed on February 28, 1946; their petition which was filed on May 19, 1947, and their amended petition which was filed June 4, 1947, all pertaining to their complaint against Water Improvement District No. 14. After hearing had the Commission found that said protest had heretofore been denied by it and that the petition and protest should be disallowed and denied.

Moved by Gray, seconded by Bailey, that the protest, the petition and the amended petition, filed by Cora Holcomb and J. D. Holcomb against Water Improvement District No. 14, be disallowed and denied. On roll call the vote was:
