Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that \$1,400 be allocated to the Welfare Department for groceries for the month of May, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the following amounts be allocated to the following for drugs and supplies for the month of May, 1938: Red Fork \$30.00; Sperry \$25.00; Skiatook \$10.00; Dr. Smith \$50.00; Sand Springs \$25.00; Collinsville \$75.00; Bixby \$50.00; Broken Arrow \$50.00; Jenks \$25.00; Dr. Motley \$75.00; Dr. Barham \$150.00; Dr. Roberts \$50.00; Dr. McGuire \$5.00; Dr. Roberts, for the jail \$100.00; For the Clinic \$100.00; To the various drug stores for prescriptions, to be divided as follows: Dr. Roberts \$100.00; Dr. McGuire \$25.00; Dr. Motley \$50.00; Dr. Barham \$225.00. To Dr. Childs is allocated \$60.00 and to Dr. Hairston \$40.00 for services and supplies. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that \$3,000 be allocated for hospitalization for the month of May, 1938, same to be divided as follows: Morningside Hospital \$1,700; Sisler Hospital \$900.00; St. Johns Hospital \$100.00; Tulsa General Hospital \$100.00; Poole Hospital \$100.00, and Flower Hospital \$100.00. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
