Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the salary of W. B. Way in the amount of \$3,000 per year or \$250.00 per month beginning November 1st, 1941, as set by the Fair Board at a meeting held November 24th, 1941, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Les Bernard be appointed Caterpillar Driver in the highway department as of November 1st, 1941, at a salary of \$140.00 per month to take the place of Charley Marshall. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Mr. Gray: Let the record show that Mack C. Carley quit the Highway Department October 1st, 1941, and has not drawn any pay from Tulsa County since that date.
