College for the correction of the erroneous assessment of the

South Half of Lot One (10, Block One Hundred Thirty Two (132) Original Town, now City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the official, plat thereof,

because said property is exempt from taxation, because used exclusively for school or educational purposes, comes on regularly to be heard before the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, regularly convened, and the application offering to introduce testimony in support of the allegations of its application, the offer of testimony is refused, and the application considered upon the statement of facts therein contained, and the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, having considered the same, finds that even if the statement of facts contained in said application is true, that said property is used for private profit and is not exempt.

IT IS THEREFORE, ordered that the application of the Tulsa Business College for the correction of the assessment on said above described preperty, be disallowed, for the reason that said property is not exempt, as said school is operated for private profit.
