

Quarter of Sec. 34, Twp. 20, N., Rge 13 E., also crossing the paved highway parallelling the St.Louis-SanFrancisco Railroad Company's Right-of-Way within the SW/4 of Sec 28, Twp. 20 N., Rge., 13 East; also any other public road or highways which may be crossed by a pipe line laid according to the blue print of survey hereto attached and made a part hereof. This line known as "Service Lines - City of Tulsa, an eight inch gas pipe line.

AND, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted and the same is hereby granted to the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.

O R D E R

NOW, On this 18th. day of August, 1926, the petition of the Sand Springs Home, a corporation, asking consent and permission of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to use the public highways and public roads, streets, alleys and public roads, streets, alleys and public places in Sections numbered, 3,4,5,6,7,8 and 9 in Township 19 North, Range 12 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma for the construction maintenance and operation thereon of water pipe lines and equipment for the transportation and furnishing of water for public and private uses to the inhabitants and consumers of said communities, came on to be heard, and the Board of County commissioners having examined said petition and being well and fully advised in the premises finds, that said petition should be granted and permission and consent given for the use by the Sand Springs Home of said public highways and roads, streets, alleys and public places for said purposes, as asked in said petition.

IT IS WHEREFORE ORDERED AND RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, that the Sand Springs Home, a corporation organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Oklahoma, having its principal office at Sand Springs, Oklahoma, be and it is hereby permitted and consent is hereby given that it have the use of the following described public highways and roads, streets, alleys and public places, to-wit:
