

THURSDAY, MAY 10th, 1945

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P. M., Thursday, May 10th, 1945, with all members present; Curtis Greer, Chairman, J. B. Gray and Robert L. Kinkaid, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Curtis Greer, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the application for Additional and Supplemental Appropriation for the General Fund of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in the amount of \$63,268.80, be and the same is hereby approved, and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the application for Additional and Supplemental Appropriation for the Dependent Separate School District, Tulsa County, in the total amount of \$1,340.81, be and the same is hereby approved, and the Chairman is authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that George C. Copeland be permitted to purchase one water tap, not to exceed 3/4", on the County Water Line extending East from Fifty-first Street and Harvard Avenue, for One Hundred and Fifty Dollars(\$150.00). Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, to accept the resignation of Russell King, Health Inspector, effective May 15, 1945. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, to accept the resignation of A. H. Neal, Health Inspector, effective April 30th, 1945. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
