RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there has been established a Federal Aid Secondary Road System for the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and approved by Federal Works Agency, Public Roads Administration, and the State Highway Commission:

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable now that the system heretofore established be enlarged and added to,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Department of Highways of the State of Oklahoma, is hereby requested to revise the Secondary System heretofore established by adding the following roads, to-wit:

From the Northwest corner of Section 36, Township 18 North, Range 13 East, to the Northeast corner of Section 34, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, and lying between Sections 27, 28 and 30, Township 18 North, Range 14 East and Section 25, Township 18 North, Range 13 East, on the North and Section 36, Township 18 North, Range 13 East, and Section 31, 32, 33 and 34, Township 18 North, Range 14 East, on the South for a distance of five (5) miles, connecting with Federal Aid Secondary Route No. 7207 on the East and Federal Aid Route No. 20 on the West.

REASONS

Part of this five (5) miles of improvement is on a School Bus and Mail Route. This Highway serves fruit and vegetable growers mainly and the type of soil being sandy it is difficult to control and maintain under present conditions.
