

across and through said public roads and highways, streets, alleys and public grounds for the purpose of transporting and for furnishing and selling to the inhabitants and consumers located in the vicinity adjacent thereto, water for domestic, public, private consumption and for beneficial uses.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said water pipe lines be placed, adjusted, laid and maintained in such manner as not to inconvenience or endanger the public in the use of said public roads and thoroughfares, streets, alleys and public places, and so as not to interfere with the free and ordinary use of same, nor the exercise of the rights of other public utilities which may be located thereon; and that the public highways and roads, streets, alleys and public places shall not be closed or obstructed, further than absolutely necessary, and after the laying and constructing of said water pipe lines said Sand Springs Home will, at its own expense, place said public highways, roads, streets, alleys and public places in the same condition of repair, as nearly as possible, as they were prior to the construction of said water pipe lines and equipment, said pipe lines and equipment to be placed and installed subject to the approval of the County Engineer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, the Sand Springs Home agreeing at all time to hold Tulsa County free from liability to third persons arising from any actionable negligence on the part of the Sand Springs Home in the construction, operation, maintenance, repair, replacing or removing of said water pipe lines and equipment.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, application having presented to this Board by the Board of Trustees of the incorporated Town of Dawson, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for permission to lay a water pipe line along certain highways.

AND, WHEREAS, it appearing to this Board to be for the best interests of the people residing along said highway and for the said Town of Dawson,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, Permission is hereby granted for the said Town of Dawson, to lay a pipe line for the purpose of carrying a water supply to said Town of Dawson, along the highway, known as the East extension of Pine Street from Harvard Avenue east to the Dawson Township Paved Highway, and thence along said Dawson Township Paved Highway to the west corporate limits of the incorporated Town of Dawson, according to the attached plat or print, showing the location of said proposed pipe line; conditioned, that said Town of Dawson will construct and lay the said pipe line at the location along the said Highway as shown on the said print or plat, and in accordance with any rules and regulations that may be prescribed by this Board, thru the County Engineer of Tulsa County and FURTHER That said Town Board of Dawson accepts this permit to lay said pipe line with the express understanding that at any time said pipe line may be in the way of any road maintenance or road construction, road betterments, etc., that they will at their own expense remove the same to such new location as may be best determined to permit such road maintenance or road betterment; that the Town Board of Dawson, will hold the County of Tulsa free from any and all public or private damages that may arise by reason of the construction of the said pipe line.
