Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the County Highway Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$50,893.52, and the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted Cash Fund in the amount of \$5,113.41, be and the same are hereby approved and the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign same and submit them to the Excise Board for consideration.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that the request of the County Treasurer for the authority for the withdrawal of Securities, County Depositors, in the amount of \$1,000 from the National Bank of Commerce, be and the same is hereby approved.
