


Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Chairman be authorized to sign and deliver the Deed to John A. Smith, as set out in the above Resolution. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
