

AND, WHEREAS, the sale of said lots by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 9745 of the compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1921, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at tax resale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treas. would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of deed therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other person having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said lots and the County of Tulsa has no need for said lots for any purpose required and provided by law whatsoever.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled and pursuant to the aforesaid statutes of the State of Oklahoma, hereby approve the sale of said property so made by the County Treasurer to R B DOWNING for a consideration of \$7.62 and it is hereby ordered that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners execute to R B DOWNING a deed conveying to him all the right, title and interest of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in and to said property, and the County Clerk of Tulsa County is hereby directed to attest with his signature and attach the seal of his office.

MONDAY, JUNE 8TH 1931.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session with all members present. W L North, Chairman, Ed W Hedgecock and W J Dickey, Members. O G Weaver, County Clerk.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with, and there being no objections to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Chairman North presiding, the following business was transacted:

It was moved by Mr. Dickey, and seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, that Mr. North, as the representative of this Board, meet at Buffalo, Oklahoma, with the representatives of other Counties of the State interested and with the officials of the Town of Buffalo, and that he and the County Attorney have full power and authority to take such action or enter into such agreement as they may deem necessary to realize, either in whole or in part, on the \$35,000.00 worth of Buffalo Water Works Bonds of 1921, held by Tulsa County in its Sinking Fund investment account. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Mr. Dickey, seconded by Mr. North, that the Affidavit of Erroneous Assessment of Klar and Goldstein, Disallowed under date of April 20th. 1931 be and the same is hereby reconsidered and ordered approved. Motion carried.
