


Monday Sept 2, 1918.

At the meeting of the Board of County Commissioners on Monday Sept 2, 1918, an order was made that the Freobe-Gray Construction Company be notified by the County Engineer to proceed with the construction of bridges No. 320-327 and 328, the same to be paid by force account but the cost not to exceed their bids for construction of aforesaid bridges as contained in their proposal of August 19th, when such bids were rejected on account of being above the Engineer's estimate.
