

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed by A. M. Landman, Superintendent of the Five Civilized Tribe, for Eliza Tiger, covering  $E\frac{1}{2} W\frac{1}{2} SE NE$ ;  $W\frac{1}{2} W\frac{1}{2} E\frac{1}{2} SE NE$ , 18-19-12, and  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ , 12-18-13, be and the same is hereby denied for the reason that there are no taxes assessed against  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ , 12-18-13 and the  $E\frac{1}{2} W\frac{1}{2} SE NE$ ;  $W\frac{1}{2} W\frac{1}{2} E\frac{1}{2} SE NE$ , 18-19-12 was sold by Tulsa County to an individual and title will have to be cleared through court, according to the County Treasurer. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the appointment of Ralph Rist as deputy Sheriff to act as day jailor at a salary of \$175.00 per month as of December 1st, 1941, as made by A.
