McGehee, L.J. Black, L.R. Renshaw, Jane Sunday, Mrs. Bettie Weir, H.W. Firey, Noah Gregory, Wm Vance, J.H. Smith, Baptist Church Red Fork, J.H. Smith and Texas Co. each filed an affidavit of erroneous assessment same was examined and ordered stricken from Tax Roll.

The following Depository Bonds were approved upon motion of Board and County Treasurer, was instructed to deposit county funds therein Merchant of Plauters Bank & the Oklahoma State Bank, The Bond of A.J. McCarney Justice of the Peace Lynn Lane Township and O.O. Brannon, Clerk of Dawson Township was on motion accepted.
